7:50-----new business---an open seat on the advisory committee was filled by Greg Wines---an instructional pilot list is being created---chain link fencing to enclose the helicopter area is being considered---there will be a fun float-fly at Tam Wax Lake on April 5, 2008 with an emergency make up date of April 6, 2008
