7:10-----meeting called to order by Bill Ackerman (president) ---membership roll was taken---all members in attendance introduced themselves---19 persons attended

7:12-----minutes from February meeting were read by Dave Temby (vice-president) ---the minutes were approved and accepted as read

7:15-----treasures report was made by Dean Brinton (treasurer)

7:20-----a discussion of association activities included the following (old business)---the Flaming Geyser Flyers Association must prepare for the state three documents each year; a financial report, activity report, and operational plan (these documents are currently being prepared)---the fly-in at Flaming Geyser Park will be May 17, it will be an informal pot luck supported by Dean Brinton's motor home chili-burgers---June 11 fly-in will include a pot luck and raffle; Jerry Roncelli and Frank O'Brien are coordinating the BBQ, Tom Franeker and Dean Brinton have volunteered their support for the pot luck---Frank O'Brien is coordinating the Boy Scout merit badge requirements with the Flaming Geyser Flyers Association capacity to help them achieve their goals---Bryan Rosenkranz suggested that the parking fee of \$5.00 is an unsettled issue; it may be totally eliminated

7:40-----more discussion (new business)---Al Padrta is heading up an effort to stain all of the benches at the flying field before the June fly-in (the stain has been purchased)---the work tables will also need to be stained this summer---It will cost the association \$40.00 a year to keep the web site operating---Dick Weaver is working with the Seattle Parks Department to obtain a permit to fly float planes on Lake Washington---the Lake Sawyer Hawks are willing to pay for the permit; however, AMA insurance would be required to fly (the permit would be an annual March to March agreement); flying time would be 10:00-3:00 every Thursday and one Saturday a month---the runway at Flaming Geyser Park needs to be rolled as soon as the ground dries out---B. J. Meekins has abdicated his position as field supervisor---the flying area is in need of weed and feed care which it will receive in a few weeks
