7:02-----meeting called to order by Bill Ackerman (president) ---membership roll was taken---22 members attended the meeting---all members introduced themselves

7:25-----old business---there will be a fly-in May 16 and June 11---the June 11 fly-in will include a raffle with about \$500.00 in prizes---donations are needed to financially support the fly-ins---members were encouraged to pass around the donation can when flying at the park---an email will be sent to all members asking for a donation---Bryan Rosenkranz announced that parking permits are no longer required

7:30-----more association business---Frank O'Brien is developing an outline which will help coordinate association involvement and Boy Scout merit badge requirements---Al Padrta has acquired stain to use on the benches and tables at the flying field---Dick Weaver and Ted Moser are coordinating efforts to roll the field (the Lake Sawyer Hawks are donating the use of their roller)

8:00-----A motion was made to nominate all existing association officers to maintain their elected position for the next year---the motion was accepted and ratified (nominations of all association staff for 2006 is complete) ---Dick Weaver explained that the Lake Sawyer Hawks have secured a permit to fly float planes on Lake Washington; AMA membership is required---see Dick Weaver for detailed guide lines (specific time and days)
