

RCA Flying Friends of Flaming Geyser State Park
Meeting Minutes
November 14, 2006

7:10-----meeting called to order by Bill Ackerman (president) ---membership roll was taken---all persons present introduced themselves

7:12-----Robert Burks (secretary) read the minutes from the September meeting---the minutes were approved and accepted as read

7:15-----Dean Brinton (treasurer) gave the treasurers report.

7:20-----Dave Temby (vice-president) gave a flying field safety report---during the last month two violation reports have been received; one violation involved landing in black berry bushes and the other occurred because of a battery disconnect

7:25-----old business---Bryan Rosenkranz (park ranger) and Josh Bolender (park ranger) explained that the flyers at Flaming Geyser State Park must conform to the Washington State Code 352-32-130.4---which means that all model aircraft must have contact information on the aircraft or a citation could be issued (\$76.00)---mowing of the airport sight is scheduled for Tuesdays and Thursdays; However, because of various weather conditions and the availability of knowledgeable mower operators the day and time of mowing will vary---club members presently responsible for mowing the field are Bill Ackerman, Al Padrta, B.J. Meekins---pilot evaluators are; Bill Ackerman, Pat Castle, Dave Temby, Rob Clemens, Dennis Long, Al Padrta---final assessment and approval (club sticker) by Bill Ackerman or Pat Castle---Dick Weaver related the latest information regarding float flying on Lake Washington (which is now on hold waiting for a permit)

7:45-----new business---the December 12 meeting will be a pot luck dinner at Flaming Geyser State Park---the club will provide plates, silverware, coffee, creamer, and soft drinks---individual members will bring their favorite dish---arrival time will be 6:00 pm and serving time will be approximately 6:30 pm---a raffle will be part of the festivities (the raffle value will be approximately \$500.00)---because of major reconstruction taking place at the park facilities (especially the restrooms) it may be necessary to assign the following week as a make up date for the pot luck meeting if facilities are still under construction and not available---the use of the buddy box as a training system was discussed and further clarification expected
